## **MOULTONBOROUGH HERITAGE COMMISSION COMMUNITY LANDMARKS SERIES**

The recently established Moultonborough Heritage Commission will host two public programs in a new Community Landmarks Series this fall. This series is intended to promote the recognition and appreciation of significant historical and cultural resources in the Town of Moultonborough. These events are free and open to the public.

On Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup>, Cristina Ashjian, Chair of the Heritage Commission, will speak on Moultonborough's country estates. Her lecture "Moultonborough's Estate Builders" will focus on the Greene brothers' estates on Long Island (Roxmont and Windermere), Dumaresq's Kona Farm on Moultonborough Neck, and Plant's Lucknow in the Ossipee Mountains, known today as the Castle in the Clouds.

On Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, resident Hollis Austin will speak on his family's historic Long Island Inn. Austin will discuss the history of the Brown family, the role of Brown's Landing in Lake Winnepesaukee transportation, and the significance of the Long Island Inn, established in 1874 as one of Moultonborough's largest boarding houses.
