**Moultonborough to Reduce Streetlights
&
Accept Nominations for More Reductions**

At its November 4th meeting the Moultonborough SelectBoard approved the reductions of 20 some streetlights anticipated to yield a 15% savings in its annual lighting budget. The list was prepared by the Police, Fire, and Public Works departments with an eye toward savings that would not reduce public safety. The locations are identified below and also have an orange placard on them. This placard will remain in place until the end of the day on Monday, November 22nd.

While it is anticipated the lights will be removed by January 1, 2011 some may never be removed at all. As part of their action the Board directed the Town Administrator to contact the Town of Center Harbor, with which the Town shares Bean Road to see if it wished to take over the lights on that road. They also directed the Town Administrator to send a letter to each of the property owners in the immediate area of a light slated for elimination to see if they wanted to “adopt” the light. Should a property owner want to do this it would cost them approximately \$150.00 per year.

Finally, the Town will post a notice on its web site letting people know they may “nominate” a light for elimination if they believe it is not needed for public safety or to service a town property. Those nominations should be emailed to the Town Administrator at cterenzini@moultonbroughnh.gov or sent by mail to the Offices of the SelectBoard, PO Box 139, Moultonborough, NH, 03254. Should someone do this it is helpful to have not only a street address but the identifying pole number in aluminum letters nailed to each pole.
